about / ART IN MOTION

In 2012, *Moving Parts* premiered at The Walt Disney Concert Hall, marking the debut of L.A. Dance Project led by Artistic Director Benjamin Millepied. For the 27-minute modern ballet, Millepied collaborated with neo-classical composer Nico Muhly, painter Christopher Wool, and Rodarte designers Laura and Kate Mulleavy. Inspired by Wool's signature gestural layering, Millepied integrated these techniques into the choreography. Nico Muhly's accompanying composition features a slow passacaglia, lyrical violin melodies, and a dynamic interplay between instruments, mirroring the intricacies of Millepied's choreography. Together, these elements create a cohesive synthesis of movement, music, and visual artistry, bringing Millepied's boundary-expanding vision for L.A. Dance Project to life on stage.

Benjamin Millepied choreographed *Triade* as a tribute to his mentor, the famed choreographer, film director, theatre director, and producer Jerome Robbins. *Triade* was commissioned by the Paris Opera Ballet in 2008, and premiered at the Palais Garnier as part of *Homage to Jerome Robbins*.
